

2024 NATIONAL SIGN & GRAPHICS AWARDS

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The entry must contain true and accurate information as to originality. All entries must be of work completed in the period from 8 March 2022 to COB 31 May 2024. **No late entries will be accepted.**
2. Entry fees for ASGA current financial members is \$40 (incl GST) per entry up to three entries received, then \$15 (incl. GST) per entry for four entries or more.
3. General entries are required to pay a fee of \$40 (inc. GST) for each entry submitted. A tax invoice will be forwarded in acknowledgement of receipt.
4. It is important that on the Details section of your Online Entry you indicate the technical skills and craftsmanship you brought to the sign creation and the challenges met and solved. **If you sub-contracted out any of the work, this must be noted in your entry.**
4. Ensure that your entry:
 - Outlines the extent of originality in the work submitted for judging (ie, client supplied logos, clip art, sketches etc).
 - Details the title and category of the work entered and the name of the designer.
 - Lists the material, suppliers and the level of originality. **If the work was not entirely completed in-house, list sub-contractors by job description that assisted on the project.**
5. It is important that, **as far as possible**, the identity of entrants cannot be determined in the work being judged when viewing the front face of the images. Therefore no promotional material, company-related personnel, business cards or graphics **ought not** appear with the images of work entered. It is likewise important that photography does not include business signage or material in the background of any images to be judged that would enable judges to identify the entrant.
6. **Identical entries may be submitted for judging in several categories, providing they give major emphasis to the particular category being entered.** Changes in presentation format would need to illustrate this. In this or similar instances, a separate entry is required for each category entered.
7. Judging will be made by an independent panel of industry professionals appointed by ASGA. The judges' decision will be final. The winner's scores are based on industry standard judging criteria and the collective decision of an independent judging panel. The judging panel will be given the discretion to make special mentions, if in their opinion, an entry is not technically correct. The judges may re-classify any entry, provided it does not disadvantage the entrant.
8. Each entry authorises ASGA or any other delegated company or person to use any entry for promotional or publishing purposes.
9. If insufficient entries are received in any category, the organisers reserve the right not to make an award in that category. If all entries are considered by the judges to be substantiated in any category awards may not be made in that category.
